

## **BIO DATA – CAPT K SRINIVASAN**

Capt K Srinivasan (70530-W) assumed the office of Principal, Sainik School Satara on 17 May 2023. An Electronics and Communication Engineering graduate, the Officer was commissioned in the Education Branch of the Indian Navy on 10 Jan 2005. Post completion of ab-initio training, the officer was posted as an Instructor at the Naval Institute of Educational and Training Technology (NIETT), Kochi from Nov 2005 to Jan 2007. The officer joined INS Zamorin as the first Education Officer of the newly commissioned Base Depot Ship in Jan 07 and was instrumental in commissioning the schooling facilities of the new establishment. In Jul 2008, the officer was selected to undergo M Tech (Electronics Design and Technology) at National Institute of Technology (NIT), Calicut. Post completion of the Post Graduation in Engineering, the officer served as Training Coordinator at NIETT(K) from Jul 2010 to May 2014. The Officer then went on to serve as Additional Director Naval Education (Exams) at IHQ MoD(N)/ Directorate of Naval Education (DNE) wherein he played a key role in the successful conduct of multiple In-service Examinations. The Officer served at INS Valsura, the Prestigious Electrical training establishment of the Indian Navy as Senior Education Officer from Apr 2017 to Jul 2021 and was also handling the Public Relations Department of the establishment. Later in Jul 2021, the officer was appointed as Senior Staff Officer (Education) at Headquarters, Eastern Naval Command (HQENC) and also served as the Director of the Navy Children School, Visakhapatnam. The officer was promoted to the rank of Captain on 01 Aug 22 and joined Sainik School Satara on 17 May 23. For his immense contribution in the field of training, the officer was commended by the FOC-in-C(South) on 04 Dec 2012.
